### A MESSAGE FROM THE SENIOR WARDEN

The season of Epiphany, where we celebrate the revelation of God in his Son as human in Jesus Christ, comes to an end on February 13, commonly known as Shrove Tuesday. On Shrove Tuesday, Christians repent of their sins and engage in a last round of merriment before the start of the somber Lenten season, which is characterized by making a Lenten sacrifice, fasting, praying, and engaging in various spiritual disciplines during the 40 days of Lent. Shrove Tuesday is often celebrated with the eating of pancakes as a way to use up rich foods such as eggs, milk, sugar, and butter before Lent, which begins on Ash Wednesday. At St. James, we will celebrate Shrove Tuesday with a baked potato bar. The details for this event and Ash Wednesday services can be found in separate articles in this month's newsletter. We hope you will join us for the meal on Shrove Tuesday and Ash Wednesday services.

During Lent, as a sign of sacrifice and to test one's self-discipline, many people decide to give something up that they love – perhaps chocolate, desserts, coffee, soda, gossip, complaining, social media, etc. Others might decide to take *up* something such as stocking our Little Food Pantry, providing warm hats, gloves, and scarves for the Neighborhood Clothesline, helping out more with chores at home, making an effort to do something nice for someone else, volunteering at a soup kitchen or homeless shelter, etc.

As we begin preparations, both individually and as a church community, for Lent, there are a number of online resources that offer daily Lenten meditations which you can find by searching "2024 Lenten

Meditations". Episcopal Relief & Development offers daily meditations sent to your email which you can subscribe to at [www.episcopalrelief.org](http://www.episcopalrelief.org). I have received the meditations from ERD for several years. It is the first email that I read before starting my day; an intentional reminder to meditate and reflect on my faith and love of God and Jesus Christ.

Another online resource that the Episcopal Church offers is through the United Thank Offering, [www.unitedthankoffering.com/lent](http://www.unitedthankoffering.com/lent). This year's theme is "40 Days of Grateful Presence" and a call to giving thanks for the many things in our lives that we take for granted with the hope that during the 40 days of Lent we can all use gratitude to help us be more present in our daily lives. The materials include a daily text message prompt to notice and give thanks for something you might take for granted, a printable calendar with the same prompts as the daily text message, a 40-days coloring sheet for families, and a Zoom book group that will read "Thanks a Thousand" by A.J. Jacobs.

If you prefer to have something to hold, we have ordered 60 copies of the 2024 Lenten Devotionals from the Society of St. Andrew which are available on the counter in The Parish Hall and on the counter outside the church office. You can also access this devotional online at [www.endhunger.org](http://www.endhunger.org). This year's theme is Hope Springs Eternal.

However you choose to mark your time during your Lenten journey, may this be a season of reflection and spiritual growth, of sacrifice or contribution for you.

“Is this not the fast that I choose: to loose the bonds of wickedness, to undo the straps of the yoke, to let the oppressed go free, and to break every yoke? Is it not to share your bread with the hungry and bring the homeless poor into your house...” (Isaiah 58:6-7)

### Afghan Resettlement Ministry February 2024 Update 01/24/2024

News from the Afghan Resettlement Ministry as we start off a new year includes the family learning about snow days! The boys enjoyed a day off from school as they kept warm in the snow and cold weather with their new coats, hats, and gloves. They are both doing well in school with mostly As and Bs on their report cards. The older boy signed up to take Art, Spanish and/or Digital Technology as his 8<sup>th</sup> grade electives next year – which are impressive for someone so new to our language and education system. The baby girl will be celebrating her 1<sup>st</sup> birthday on February 10 and recently received her birth certificate after waiting for nearly a year. We all look forward to celebrating her birthday as this first year has brought so much joy to us and her family. Perhaps the best example of the family's adjustment to American culture is that the father started off the new year with a gym membership! He and the family will be sharing their story during Sunday School at 9:00am on February 4 and 11 at Christ Episcopal Church. Everyone is invited to come meet them and learn more about their life before and after fleeing from Afghanistan.

Now that our first Afghan family is getting along so well, the ECS Team has decided to sponsor a second family from Afghanistan. The family - which includes a father, mother and four children (ages 2 to 13) arrived in the area six weeks ago and have settled in Salem. The father is a civil engineer and is looking for employment in this field - if anyone has contacts or would like to help mentor him as he learns to navigate a career path in America, which would be greatly appreciated! The three older children enrolled in the Salem school system in late January and we will help them get settled and provide whatever tutoring they may need. Most pressing at this point is they need furniture! Specific items include beds (3 twins, 1 toddler, and a full), 4 dressers, 2-3 living room chairs, 2 rugs, 3-5 pillows or cushions (as they tend to sit on the floor while eating), a table and chairs for the children to do homework, table and/or floor lamps, bath towels, and diapers.
